Wildcamping Map & POI User Guide – France & Iberia

3,930 places throughout France! And 2,117 places in Portugal and Spain!

These are provided as just two files, one for France and one for Iberia, comprising free and chargeable aires, and a rapidly growing number of urban and rural wilding spots too!

For France and Iberia you will also find a number of tap locations listed. These have the prefix WS (water standpipe).

Please note the information provided in this document is additional to the User Guide for England, Wales and Scotland, and should be read after you have read that document.

IMPORTANT: Note that this is a **REPLACEMENT** for all the information you may have already downloaded. **Remember that some locations have been DELETED.**

NEW! From this release onwards, locations known to have access restrictions will have their names enclosed in square brackets e.g. [CR Bordeaux]

It is highly advisable with such locations to check them out with Google Earth or the Wild Camping app before travelling. The description will tell you what the restriction comprises – it may advise use by smaller vehicles and/or it may advise to approach from a specific direction.

Contents

Included are files named France and Iberia using the same folder structure as that used for England, Wales & Scotland.

The files provided are for use with Tom Tom and Garmin satnav devices, as well as Google Earth, each in an appropriately named folder. Further details about the use of these files is contained within the User Guide - England, Wales & Scotland.

In the France and Iberia POI files, each entry is categorised by prefixing the location description as follows:

CR – car park rural
CU – car park urban

OU – other urban
OR – other rural

LR – layby rural
LU – layby urban

AC – aire chargeable
AF – aire free

Comments have been added where useful. These are only accessible in the Wild Camping apps, Google Earth or AutoRoute.

For example, the comments contain information about:

- Costs for aires that charge
- Access restrictions
- A TinyURL or Google link to the Streetview image where available

All the GPS positions have been confirmed using Google Maps.
