CAMPER VANS

Thank you to everyone who has been in touch with us regarding the long-running issue of camper vans and some other vehicles parking overnight, and often for longer, at Kings Parade and Coastal Drive.

As we reported in our last newsletter, we arranged for this issue to be on the agenda for a recent meeting at the Town Hall. At that meeting, residents highlighted some of the issues that arise from long-stay parking.

Notes from the meeting at the Town Hall, along with a map showing the extent and nature of the parking changes are attached to this letter.

A small working group was set up to oversee the introduction of a temporary 'Traffic Regulation Order' that will prohibit overnight parking. There will be a review of the measures next summer to see if they have had the desired effect.

At the same time, camper van owners are to be encouraged to use the established locations in Wirral where services such as water, toilets and refuse disposal are available.

Councillor Lesley Rennie attended a further meeting this week and it was confirmed that the Highways Department will be introducing these measures within the next few weeks.


